

Making Word Blocks

Game Instructions:

(One player)

1. Cut out all of the word endings and organize into piles.
2. Place the word ending game board in front of your student.
3. Have your student start with ong ending and work his/her way to the unk ending. Start at the bottom of the chart and have your student place the correct ending next to the letter. Then have him/her read the combined word. Do one column at a time working from bottom to top.
4. For every word your student reads correctly, he/she gets one point.
5. The goal of the game is to get the most points.

Game Instructions:

(2 or more players)

1. Cut out all of the word endings and organize into piles.
2. Each student will need his/her own word ending game board.
3. Place the word ending game boards in front of your students.
4. Start with one student and have him/her start with ong ending and work his/her way to the unk ending. Start at the bottom of the chart and have him/her place the correct ending next to the letter. Then have him/her read the combined word. Do one column at a time working from bottom to top.
5. Alternate students from word to word within the columns.
6. Every word read correctly gets one point.
7. The winner of the game is the student that gets the most points.
